ask

What makes you, you? Is it the place you come from? Is it the places your great-grandparents come from? Talk to your family about where you come from and what makes that place special.

discover

What is the culture of the places your family comes from? Culture is a word to describe the way a certain group of people live their life. Use your senses to discover those places.

- What colours, dances and clothes do you think of?
- What can you hear?
- What languages do people speak; what songs do they sing?
- What can you smell?
- What flowers grow there; what food do people eat?
